

BUILDING CODE OF AUSTRALIA (BCA) COMPLIANCE

P.2.1 - Structural stability and resistance to actions:

The ALWP™ cladding system has been tested to the structural sequence of AS4284-2008 - Testing of Building Facades, in order to provide evidence of satisfying BCA Volume 2 Performance Requirements P2.1 - structural stability and resistance to actions - for up to wind category N3.

P.2.2.2 - Weatherproofing

The ALWP™ cladding system has been tested to the weatherproofing sequence of AS4284-2008 - Testing of Building Facades, in order to provide evidence of satisfying BCA Volume 2 Performance Requirements P2.1 - structural stability and resistance to actions - for up to wind category N3.

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In Victoria, the BRAC is responsible for assessing product accreditation applications against the Performance Requirements of the BCA, where no Deemed-to-Satisfy Provisions exist in the BCA, as applicable to Victoria.

The ALWP™ cladding system has been assessed and deemed by the BRAC to satisfy BCA Performance Requirements P2.1 and P2.2.2 for wind category N3 as stipulated in BRAC certificate V12/02 and when installed in accordance with this installation manual.
